

Take Care of Your New Seed!

Proper Care Of Your Newly Seeded Lawn Is Important.

PLEASE WATER YOUR NEW SEED.

GreenPro Services provides an elite variety of seed blends which may consist of Bluegrass, Perennial Rye, or Fescue depending on your selection. Starter fertilizer and straw covering have also been applied.

Please water immediately to wet the straw down to prevent the wind from blowing it away. Keeping the straw in place is important to good seed germination. Replace any straw that has been displaced by the wind.

Remember your seed cannot begin growing until it receives adequate moisture, so please begin watering immediately.

GreenPro Services is not responsible for weather conditions that may wash out seed or blow away the straw.

Your Lawn Will Only Look As Good As the Amount of Work You Put Into It!

WATERING: If watered properly, your seed will germinate within 7-14 days. We recommend oscillating sprinklers applying 1/2" of water per day for one week. The seeded area should be kept wet enough so that it is difficult to walk on. Traffic should be kept to a minimum. After the seed germinates, 1" of water per watering is required to keep seed moist.

MOWING: Newly seeded lawns should be mowed as soon as possible with sharp mower blades set between 2-1/2 to 3 inches. Any small rocks that are exposed due to the heavy watering should be removed beforehand. Follow these mowing guidelines: In Spring, cut to 2 to 2-1/2 inches tall. In Summer, cut to 3 to 3-1/2 inches tall. In the Fall, cut to 2 to 2-1/2 inches tall. When determining height, measure from the ground up. In the summer, always water after mowing. Never cut more than 1/3 of the total height of the existing grass blades. Always keep your mower blades sharpened.

FERTILIZING AND WEED CONTROL: After the second mowing, starter fertilizer with a high nitrogen content and quick release should be applied. Remember to water immediately after fertilizing. Should dormant weed seeds germinate, apply a weed and feed. Weed and feed should be applied in the morning before the dew has evaporated and shouldn't be watered for 24 hours. After the lawn has become established, we recommend a complete lawn care program throughout the year. Consult a professional lawn care service if needed.
